All applicants must demonstrate their English Language competency in one of the following ways:

PRIMARY LANGUAGE PATHWAY:

- a. English is their primary language; and
- b. They have attended and satisfactorily completed at least six years of primary and secondary education taught and assessed solely in English in a recognised country*, including at least two years between years 7 and 12.

*Recognised countries: Australia, Canada, New Zealand, Republic of Ireland, South Africa, United Kingdom, and USA.
